

POLICY ON INSTALLATION OF SATELLITE DISHES

The following policy applies to all residents of Dayton Housing Authority who wish to install satellite dishes.

1. Satellite dishes may not exceed one meter in diameter (3 feet, 3 inches) measured across at the widest part.
2. Satellite dishes may not be installed in a manner that would enable them to fall on people from above. Dishes must be mounted securely and must not be mounted on windows, window frames, or on trees.
3. Satellite dishes may not be installed in ways that damage units, buildings or grounds. No holes may be drilled in railing, exterior walls, or siding during installation. (Clamp type mountings are permitted.)
4. Satellite dishes may not be mounted on exterior walls, common areas, roofs, or any other common areas outside the residents own unit. Due to underground utilities, dishes may not be pole mounted in yards.
5. Professional installation is required and must be inspected by a representative from Dayton Housing Authority. Residents may not install satellite dishes themselves.
6. Dayton Housing Authority must approve the location of the dish prior to installation. This permission must be in writing from Dayton Housing Authority.
7. Resident must accept responsibility for any liability for injury to persons or property caused by the satellite dish.
8. Resident agrees to indemnify and hold Dayton Housing Authority harmless from any and all liability from, in relation to or associated with the satellite dish and related equipment.
