Dear Resident:

This letter is to inform you of a new Trash and Litter Control Policy that will become effective on April 1, 1999. In order to control the accumulation of garbage it is necessary for everyone to cooperate in this effort.

Prior to April 1, we will supply every non-elderly unit that has two or more bedrooms with two covered garbage cans. Between weekly garbage pickup, garbage must be kept in the cans with the cover on. On the day of garbage pickup, please carry your garbage cans to the curb and return them to your apartment after the cans has been emptied. If garbage has been scattered during pickup, please take the time to pick it up from the sidewalk or street.

Let me also take this opportunity to remind you that Dayton Housing Authority will pick up junk that you place on the curb on the first Thursday of each month. There will not be a charge for this service. However, it is your responsibility to see that the items are placed on the curb no earlier that Wednesday evening. Please do not store these items on your porches or in your yard while you are waiting for them to be picked up.

If you are saving aluminum cans, please store them in a covered container and not in garbage bags in your yards. If these bags are outside, they also attract rats and roaches. We hope that this policy will make our communities more attractive and enjoyable for everyone.
